Chapter XXI, Section 12-11, Smoking in Public Places, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

- 12-11 Prohibition of Smoking in Public Places and Workplaces
- 12-11.1 **Definitions.** When used in this section, the following words and phrases shall have the following meanings:

12-11.2 General Restrictions

- A. Regulation of smoking in places accessible to the general public:
- (a) All enclosed public and work areas available to and generally used by the general public, including but not limited to:

- all businesses and non-profit entities;
- laundromats
- 6) museums;

- galleries and libraries;
- 8) auditorium stages;
- performance halls;
- recital halls or any venue wherein performances or demonstrations occur;
- 11) sports arenas or gymnasiums;
- 12) all areas of healthcare facilities;
- <u>1</u>3) all lobbies, hallways or common areas of multi-unit commercial buildings;
- 4 all lobbies, hallways or common areas of multi-unit residential buildings;
- 15) polling places; and
- 16) private residences that are used as childcare or healthcare facilities.
